FAQs

- Is there a waitlist? Our classes fill quickly. If you are interested in enrolling your child for
 the 2025-26 school year, please contact the Franklin location at
 learningcenter@rollinghills.church and the Nolensville location at
 sabrina.jenkins@rollinghills.church. We will contact you if a spot becomes available during
 the school year.
- How many days can my child attend the Learning Center each week?
 - Franklin Location: We place children in classrooms based on their age as of the 1st day of school. Babies, 1's and 2's classes have the option of our 2 day program (T/Th) or 3 day program (T/W/Th). Our 3's and PreK classes have the option of enrolling in the 3 day program (T/W/Th) or 4 day program (Mon. Thurs).
 - Nolensville Location: All ages have a 2 day option, either M/W or T/Th
- What ages do you accept at the Learning Center? 6 months to 5 years old
- Is the Learning Center at Rolling Hills full-time/year-around care? No. The Learning Center follows the Williamson County School schedule and takes breaks accordingly. This includes summer break. The school year is in session from mid August to mid May.
- Do we have SRO on-site? Yes
- Is your program licensed? Our Franklin location is licensed. Our Nolensville location is not.
- What ages nap at the Learning Center and what do I provide for nap time? Babies, 1's and 2's classes nap. 3's and PreK classes do not nap. The Learning Center will provide a cushioned mat. We ask that families bring a sheet and blanket or nap mat to lay on top. Children are also welcome to bring a lovey if they are 1 year or older. Pacifiers are welcome for any napping age.
- **Is food provided?** No. The Learning Center requires that families provide a water bottle, snack and lunch each day for their child.
- **Are you a nut free school?** No. We base restrictions on the needs of the friends in your child's classroom. If someone in the classroom has an allergy, we will notify all families in the classroom to avoid bringing said food item to class.
- What enrichment programs are offered? Art, Music and Chapel for all ages. STEM available for 3's and PreK classes at the Franklin location.
- **What would be my child's daily routine?** This varies based on age. However, most classes have free-play, child-led activities, teacher-led activities, outdoor time, circle time, nap/quiet time, lunch and snack time.
- Do the students stay in their classroom most of the day? No, we are blessed to have a
 large facility where students can move and get their wiggles out, even on rainy days. Our
 classes take walks/stroller rides, play outside, and spend time on our indoor play
 structures.
